## Format

Admission: \$5.00 for Adults \$3.00 for children under the age of 13



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Uniforms: Home team will be the top team listed in the bracket.

Both teams need to have a home and away uniform to avoid color conflicts.

Officials: Two IHSAA licensed officials for each game

Game Times: All games are expected to start on time. If a team is late the tournament director has the right to declare a grace period or to declare a forfeit depending on the shootout schedule. Only the tournament director may declare a forfeit, this decision is not subject to protest. Referees do not have the authority to declare a forfeit.

Games may begin early if coaches and referees agree.

Equipment/Clock/Scorekeeper: Basketballs will be provided by Franklin County High School for warm-ups for each court in use.

The home team needs to provide a clock operator and the visiting team needs to provide a scorekeeper.

Waiver/Liability: This Event is not sponsored by or in any way affiliated with the Franklin County School Corporation. Any and all Corporation employees who participate with the students in the event are doing so on their own time, outside the scope of their employment with the Corporation and not as employees of the Corporation. The Corporation has not participated in playing the event activities and has no control or right of control of such activities. 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## Game Format

All players, coaches, and spectators are expected to show respect toward, game officials, players, and coaches, tournament volunteers and staff. Verbal and/or physical abuse, including profanity shall not be tolerated. Any misconduct may result in disqualification from the tournament for the individual and/or team.

All Teams MUST have a adult coach on the bench during all game situations

### **4th Grade Teams: NO PRESSING, Man to Man defense**

Unless otherwise specified below all tournament games shall be played under the rules of the IHSAA

Games two 16 minute running clock per half. Clock will run continuously if the point difference exceeds 20 points.

Clock stops the last minute of 1st half and last two minutes of 2nd half unless the difference in score exceeds 20 points.

Halftime intermission will be 3 minutes Overtime shall be 2 minutes in length if the tie continues it will go into sudden death.

Timeouts: 1 60 second and 1 30 second timeout per half. No carry over in Timeouts

Free-throws will be as 1 shot per attempt. Each free throw will be worth either 2 or 3 points depending on the spot of the foul. Except for 1 and 1 situations those will be done in accordance of IHSAA rules

All decisions by the tournament director shall be final These rules are subject to change up to the day of the tournament.
