#### Shootout Format

This shoot-out is for school feeder and travel programs grades 6-8. There will be 3 gym floors and concessions will be provided. **There is a 3 game guarantee.**

**Admission: \$5.00**

#### Food & Drink Items:

Coaches, and players are permitted to bring food and drink items into the tournament provided that these items are individual serving sizes. This is a fundraising event and fans, coaches, and players are encouraged to support South Newton Lady Rebels Basketball by purchasing items at the Concession Stand. Thanks in advance for your support.

#### Uniforms

The team listed first on the schedule is considered the home team. The home team must have an alternate colored jersey available and be prepared to change, if in the opinion of the game officials, there is a color conflict. Please bring reversible jerseys or a home/away uniforms.

#### Game Start Times:

All game officials shall be expected to start the games on time. If a team is late, the Tournament Director has full authority to declare a grace period, to declare a forfeit, or to adjust the length of the game, depending on the shoot-out schedule requirements. Only the Tournament Director may declare a forfeit. This decision is not subject to protest. Game referees do not have the authority to declare a forfeit. Games may begin earlier than listed start time on schedule if coaches and referees are in agreement.

#### Equipment/Clock/Scorekeeper:

Basketballs will be provided by South Newton High School for warm-ups. South Newton High School will provide a game ball for each court in use. South Newton High School will provide a clock operator, score official, and referees. We will have a trainer on duty as well for any medical needs.

#### Waiver/Liability

The Event is not sponsored by or in any way affiliated with the South Newton School Corporation. Any and all Corporation employees who participate with the students in the Event are doing so on their own time, outside the scope of their employment with the Corporation, and not as employees of the Corporation. The Corporation has not participated in planning or scheduling any event activities and has no control or right of control of such activities. #### Game Format

- All players, coaches, and spectators are expected to show respect toward game officials, players, fans, and tournament volunteers and staff. Verbal and/or physical abuse, including profanity, shall not be tolerated. **Any misconduct may result in disqualification from the tournament for the individual(s) and/or team involved.**
- All teams must have an adult coach whom shall be on the bench during all game situations, including warm-ups, postgame, and between games.
- All players should have responsible adult supervision to enforce sportsmanlike attitudes and behaviors.
- Further, it is expected that all adults, family members, and fans in a team's delegation set an example of good sportsmanship, and if necessary, enforce a spirit of good sportsmanship and respect among their team and its supporters.
- Unless otherwise specified below, all tournament games shall be played under the rules of the IHSAA.
- Games shall be played with two 15 minute running clock halves. Clock will run continuously if difference in score exceeds 20 points. If a team is winning by 15 or more points, they must cease all full court pressure.
- Clock stops last 2 minutes of each half on a whistle unless difference in score exceeds 20 points.
- Halftime intermission shall be 3 minutes. (This may be adjusted accordingly)
- Overtime periods shall be 2 minutes. If there is a tie after overtime, it will go into sudden death (first point wins)
- Each team shall receive two 60 second timeout per half and 1 one 60 second timeout per overtime period with no carry-over of timeouts.
- For the first 13 minutes of each half, all shooting fouls will be awarded 1 free-throw attempt. If a foul was committed during a 3 point attempt the free-throw will be worth 3 points and a 2 point attempt worth 2 points.
- Will keep foul totals, however, no foul outs. On a player receiving a 6th foul (or any additional foul), the opposing team will be awarded 2 points and the ball.

All decisions by the Tournament Director shall be final.

These rules are subject to change up to the day of the tournament.
