Game Rules

- Games will be 18 minute running clock halves.
 - Clock will stop last minute of first half and last two minutes of second half (unless point spread is 15 or higher in last two minutes, then it will run)
- When the clock is running.....
 - Shooting fouls will be one shot for two (or three) points
 - Bonus and double bonus fouls will be one shot for two points
- When the clock is not running.....
 - Regular free throw rules apply
- Halftime will be three-five minutes long
 - May vary slightly to help stay on schedule
- Overtime will be two minutes long (clock will stop)
- Double overtime will be sudden death
- Teams get one timeout for the first half and two for the second half
 - no carryover of the first half timeout
- Warmups will be three minutes to however long there is until the scheduled tip time
- All IHSAA rules apply except what is noted above.

Schedule

- There are four five team pools. All teams will play 4 pool games and a game against a corresponding finisher in another pool. The first place finishers will play a championship game (the only two teams that will play six total games are the top two finishers).
 - Tie-Breakers for pool standings
 - Head-to-head
 - Fewest Points Allowed
 - Coin Toss
